

This raked theatre seats 140 delegates integrated AV. A comfortable and well-presented room for presentations and lectures; there is a low stage with lectern and space for panels or top tables.

AV can be controlled via the lectern, from the rear of the room and by a technician from our AV office. 


### Syndicate Rooms 3&4




70 parking spaces are available at our car park accessed via Storeys' Way. Spaces are on a first-come, first-served basis.
